

## COST OF ATTENDANCE

Cost of Attendance (COA) is used to give an idea of the average cost of attending school. There are Direct and Indirect\* costs included in the COA. Some additional costs may be required that are not directly billed to the student and may be different than what is listed; however, the student is responsible for those expenses.

Direct costs are items that will appear on your Francis Tuttle invoice, such as tuition and fees.

Indirect costs will not appear on your invoice but are **estimated** costs associated with going to school and should be included in your personal budget. Most of these costs would be incurred whether you attend school or not. These include items like food and housing, transportation, and personal expenses.

Additional costs are either a required or optional **estimated** expense for the career major you are enrolled in and generally will not appear on your invoice. For additional information regarding these items, please contact your academic advisor.
