

As Associate Superintendent, Dr. Jaared Scott provides visionary leadership and oversight of Francis Tuttle's career training programs, college preparatory academies and workforce and economic development initiatives. He joined Francis Tuttle in October 2012 as the Executive Director of Technology & Facilities.

Prior to his employment with Francis Tuttle, Jaared was a Technology Center Coordinator at the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education (ODCTE) in Stillwater, OK.
