The Next Step Tuition Waiver provides qualifying students with a tuition waiver for one field of study in a long-term Career Training program. The waiver cannot be used for books, clothing, and any other materials or fees required by their program.

To qualify, students must have a diploma from one of Francis Tuttle Technology Center's partner schools, or have lived within the Francis Tuttle Technology Center school district upon high school graduation. Applicants must begin their first Career Training program before their twenty-first birthday to qualify.

In order to keep the scholarship, students must adhere to the 91% attendance policy, maintain a grade of "C" or better, and remain in good standing within the policies and procedures of Francis Tuttle Technology Center.

Students receiving federal student aid are also eligible to receive the Next Step Tuition Waiver.

FAQ's for the Next Step Tuition Waiver

- **Can I use the tuition waiver for more than one program?**

For adult students who began their program after July 1, 2017, the tuition waiver can only be used for *one field of study*. You may get as many certificates as you like within that field of study, as long as you begin the plan of study for that certificate before your 21st birthday. Students who began their program prior to July 1, 2017, may qualify for up to 1080 of tuition. However, the student must have been enrolled within 15 months of their high school graduation. If a student withdraws and returns to school within the 15 months since the high school graduation date, s/he will continue to receive the tuition waiver.

- **Will I still be able to use the tuition waiver if I am on a waitlist before my 21st birthday?**

You must start your program before you turn 21 in order to qualify for the Next Step Tuition Waiver. In some cases, a program might have a long wait list, so it's important to apply early in order to guarantee a start date in your program before your 21st birthday.

- **Can I receive the Next Step Tuition Waiver if I have a GED?**

No. In order to qualify for the Next Step Tuition Waiver, you must have a high school diploma from one of the high schools in Francis Tuttle district, or have a completion certificate from a home-school program and live in the Francis Tuttle district.
