

## **PREREQUISITE COURSES FOR THE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM**

Prior to being admitted to the program, students must successfully complete the following prerequisite courses:

1. Medical Terminology: Must have a letter grade of “C” or higher; must be from an accredited institution (College = 2 or 3 credit hours or at a CareerTech = 45 hours minimum).
2. Human Anatomy and Physiology: Must have a letter grade of “C” or higher; must be from an accredited institution (College = 3 or 4 credit hours or CareerTech = 120 hours).

These courses must be completed two weeks prior to the first day of class, but do not have to be completed to apply or get conditionally accepted into the program.

There is no time limit on how long ago the classes were taken.

Francis Tuttle Technology Center offers classes for both prerequisite courses.

Therefore, no college credit is granted from Francis Tuttle Technology Center for Human Anatomy and Physiology and Medical Terminology.*
