

FRANCIS TUTTLE - FINANCIAL AID ASPIRE TUITION WAIVER APPLICATION

Students enrolled in any Career Training program except Respiratory Care may apply for the Aspire Tuition Waiver. **This tuition waiver is available to Oklahoma residents who begin their program between July 1, 2026, and June 30, 2027.** Students may receive a tuition waiver for up to two programs, including the Next-Step Tuition Waiver. The waiver cannot be used for books, clothing, or any other materials or fees required by their program. To establish eligibility, the student must meet one of the qualifications below.
