- If you or your spouse have filed a 2024 Federal Income Tax Return with the IRS:
 - Select A under Independent Student's Information and Spouse's Information as appropriate on the 2nd page of this Form. As part of the Federal Student Aid eligibility, students, and spouses (as appropriate), will be required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective.
